

**CNHARC – Steering Committee  
Minutes – Meeting on October 13, 2003**

The October Steering Committee meeting was held at Dick Christopher's home on October 13, 2003. Present were:

The meeting was called to order by President Dave Megin – KA1VJU at 7:15 PM.

The treasurer, Joe, reported a balance of approx. \$3,100 in the checking account. Joe recommended that club events (field day, Christmas party, etc.) should pay for themselves. Considerable discussion followed. No follow up or motions were made.

A list of current club members will be sent with the next communicator. This may help to remind those members who have not renewed to do so.

Rich was present to review the status of the 6 meter surplus rigs that are now on the market and to present his ideas for a 6 meter repeater. A web site exists for info on parts, components, etc. It is gemoto.com. Rich made a phone call and verified that a friend of his had listed these radios on ebay. Rich negotiated a sale of 15 radios complete except for power supply and antenna for \$60. Ten of those present said they would buy a radio at that price. Dick will collect the money and work with Rich on delivery.

Jack Barbera (WA1ZDV) has agreed to serve on the steering committee as Program coordinator. Wray (KB1JVZ) was recognized as doing a good job as our new publicity officer.

Cliff reported that the Center Harbor police chief has asked for help from club members with a Halloween patrol on Oct. 30. Cliff will coordinate the event.

Jack, Doug and Wray will serve as a committee to study the feasibility of using the Chevy Lumina van as a mobile station for club events. Sponsors would be needed to support the project financially. Insurance and vehicle storage are issues to be addressed.

A suggestion was made to divide the club membership into several small groups and assign responsibility for membership meeting programs. No action was taken. Jack requested a copy of a former questionnaire were members were asked to give their ideas in meeting programs. No action was assigned.

It was agreed that a mini flea market would be held at the Jan. '04 membership meeting.
