

**Minutes – CNHARC Steering  
Committee – on the air – 11/7/05**

The Nov. 2005 Steering Committee was held on the air on Nov. 7, 2005. The following committee members checked in:

President Dave called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM.

Cliff also announced that Tink Taylor reported on reorganization of the Red Cross organization in Laconia. Jack announced that he will contact Tink Taylor to see if he can help with club publicity.
